ST. FRANCIS OF ASSISI

The Patron of the School

The school is named after the immortal St. Francis of Assisi. According to a survey, he is the greatest man born during the second millennium. Men and women, regardless of creed, color, and nationality, have acclaimed him as the world's most influential social and religious reformer.

Francis was born in Assisi, Italy, in 1182 as the son of Peter Bernadone and Pica. He received his primary education at St. George Church. At fourteen, he joined his father's business as a merchant. He enjoyed music and dance and was very popular among his friends. At seventeen, he was drawn into the civil war in the city. When he was twenty years old, Assisi was defeated in a war with Perugia, and Francis was imprisoned. When released, Francis returned home in broken health. But on the way, he fell ill. During his recovery, he had a mysterious dream that changed his life completely.

Upon his return to Assisi, Francis was no longer interested in fame, power, or wealth. Moved by God's grace, he opted for a life of poverty. He spent his time in prayer, austerity, and service to others. Jesus Christ and His Gospel deeply influenced Francis. He formulated rules for men and women who desired to follow him. He went about for several years proclaiming the message of peace, joy, and love to all. St. Francis died in 1226. His followers, known as "Franciscans," constitute the largest group within the Catholic Church.

Throughout the centuries, millions of admirers worldwide have been attracted by the life and ideals of St. Francis. His charm is perennial, and his personality universal. Mahatma Gandhi used to recite the peace prayer of St. Francis every day.

St. Francis saw God's goodness in every creature. His "Canticle of the Sun" is considered the most beautiful poem in Italian. He is honored as the universal patron of Ecology and the Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals.

Love was the theme of St. Francis's life, and peace was his message. Assisi has become a synonym for peace. The World Conference of Peace, attended by leaders from every religion, was held in Assisi in 1987 and 2002.

The first group of Franciscans arrived in India in 1292. Since then, the sons and daughters of St. Francis have contributed immensely to the development of our country. Our school is truly proud to have such an illustrious patron. May St. Francis help us to live the values he cherished most: simplicity, peace, love, and universal brotherhood.

Information

St. Francis School, Mysore-Bangalore Road, is a CBSE English-medium co-educational school run by the Franciscan Fathers and Brothers, who are members of the Third Order Regular (T.O.R.) of St. Francis of Assisi, after whom the school is named. It is governed by the Bangalore Shanti Sadhana Society, which is a religious, charitable, and educational organization registered under the Societies Registration Act 1860. Staffed by dedicated and highly qualified fathers, sisters, and teachers, the T.O.R. Franciscans run many schools in India and abroad, in which young people belonging to every creed, social class, community, and linguistic group are educated through the medium of English and other languages. These institutions are part of the Catholic Church's effort to share in the country's educational understanding. This effort, while particularly responsible to the Christian community, has always been at the service of the whole nation. Thus, in these institutions, recognized as Christian Minority Institutions, the primary purpose is to educate Christian children; however, non-Christian children may also be admitted. The religious beliefs of all students are treated with respect.

Established on 18 June 2015, the school is situated amid a large and resplendent campus. The ambiance inside the campus is serene and salubrious, facilitating a proper environment for education and fruitful training in life. The institution has a holistic approach to education whereby the scholastic performance of the pupil is reinforced by Christian and Franciscan ideals of universal brotherhood, love, peace, joy, and kindness, in which the school believes. Exemplary discipline, outstanding academic performance, and excellence in co-curricular and extracurricular activities are the hallmarks of every St. Francis student. It is manned by dedicated, competent, and highly qualified fathers, sisters, and teachers who create and foster the ethos for the all-round growth of the students. St. Francis School arms every student with the strength of character that enables him/her to face the fiercely competitive society of today with ease and confidence.

Vision

To spread the love of God in the spirit of St. Francis of Assisi by imparting the values of human dignity, brotherhood, equality, justice, and peace.

Mission Statement

Our mission is to develop young men and women with active and creative minds, a sense of understanding and compassion for others, and the courage to act on their beliefs. We stress the total development of each child: spiritual, moral, intellectual, social, emotional, and physical.

Objectives

"For God and Country" is the motto of St. Francis School. To ingrain the value of 'Service before self, to inculcate the importance of duty to fellow beings before expecting rights has been the constant endeavor of the school. The Franciscan Society aims at the integral development of the whole person, enlightened leadership, social responsibility, and commitment to nation-building. The school believes in the integral development of the whole person, emphasizing value and quality education to prepare them to face the challenges of life. Special attention is given to ensuring a high standard of morality and discipline in the school. The students will be prepared for the C.B.S.E New Delhi, which has been recognized by the Government of India as one of the main All India School examining bodies.

Curriculum

The medium of instruction is English, but very special emphasis is given to Kannada, the mother tongue. The complete curriculum consists of English, Kannada, Hindi, the Official Language, History, Geography, Social Studies, Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Physical Training, Computer Application, Ai, Robotics and Coding, Commercial Studies, Fine Arts, etc.

The school places a great deal of stress on character formation and the development of religious and ethical values, which are imparted regularly to students through the teaching of Moral Science. The Social Service League (SSL) actively encourages students to help generate the spirit of "Service to Humankind".

Rules and regulations of the school

1. St. Francis students should behave in a gentlemanly manner on their way to and from the school. They are reminded that the school is judged by their conduct.
2. Students must be regular and punctual. The school gate will be closed at the first bell at 9:20 a.m. Latecomers will not be allowed to enter the school

premises. At 9:20 am all the students must be present for the school assembly.

3. Students are not allowed to leave the school premises during school hours or recess without the explicit permission of the Principal/ Vice Principal. No child will be sent home even if any urgent need arises, unless a duly authorized person comes to fetch him/her with a note of authority from the parents. This is considered only after filling out the leave note form which is available in the office.
4. All the students must extend their cooperation in the proper upkeep of all the property of the school.
 - a. The students should not scratch or spoil the desks, benches, chairs, etc.
 - b. The students should not damage any furniture of the school or the belongings of others. Damage done even by accident should be reported at once to the Class Teacher. Recovery against any such damage must be done up by the concerned students with a fine imposed on him/her/them for such a misdeed. Such misdeeds may entail expulsion from the school also.
5. Politeness and courtesy of speech are much emphasized. Students spilling ink, littering papers, scribbling on the school desks or walls, stealing or damaging other students' belongings or school property will be liable to deserve punishment to the extent of a heavy fine, cover the damage, suspension, or even dismissal.
6. Students are not allowed to give gifts to teachers.
7. The school will not be responsible for any loss of articles of the students. All articles found in the school and not claimed for shall be disposed of after a month. Students are not permitted to bring valuable articles to school. Students shall take good care of their books and personal belongings. Each article should be marked with the pupil's name, admission number, and class.
8. Outdoor games physical education and work experience will be compulsory for all the students. Exemption may be granted only after parents meet the Principal or with a written application for the same and if the reason is found valid. Parents or any school matters and phone calls will attend only during school hours.

9. Students are advised to contribute generously when collections are taken for the poor and the needy, for any other humanitarian cause, or during any calamities.
10. In case of doubt regarding the interpretation of the school rules, the decision of the discipline committee (i.e. School Managing Committee) is final.
11. English shall be spoken at all times on the premises by the students and teachers.
12. School diary should be brought to the school daily. Magazines, Newspapers, etc. are not to be brought to the school.
13. All children are expected to bring the tiffin with them for the noon recess.
14. Parents and guardians are not allowed to see their children to visit teachers or to enter the school veranda during school hours.
15. All homework should be done neatly and the day's work always be dated.
16. All the students are expected to take an active part in all co-curricular activities.
17. Students should treat others respectfully and be responsible for other's good names. Calling nicknames, spreading rumors, etc. are strictly forbidden.
18. Students must obtain the Principal's permission for late arrivals or absences. Those absent on the first day after vacations will incur a Rs. 100/per day fine, Rs. 20 for unexcused absences otherwise. Leave of absence requires a written application from the guardian. If unauthorized absence exceeds 15 days, the defaulter's name will be struck off the rolls and considered withdrawn.
19. Admission of absentees to class is granted only when they show the class teacher the Regularity Record duly countersigned by the Principal/Vice Principal.

The School Uniform

St. Francis School believes in the sacred responsibility of inculcating in the young pupils a sense of neatness and cleanliness. The students have to come to school neatly dressed in their school uniform prescribed by the school.

20. Wearing the school uniform daily is mandatory. Hence, children should have an adequate supply of uniforms.

Weekly Uniform Schedule:

Monday & Thursday: Ivory shirt, red tie, blazer, with navy-blue skirt/pants

Tuesday & Friday: Sky blue check shirt with navy-blue skirt/pants (No tie and blazer)

Wednesday & Saturday: School tracksuit (for physical education and activities)

21. Personal cleanliness is crucial. Nails should be trimmed regularly, shoes polished, and hairstyles neat—boys with short hair and girls with proper braids. Additionally, wearing an ID card is mandatory.
22. Students who are not appropriately dressed and groomed may be excluded from the class.

Admission

23. Children must be 3 years old for Pre-KG and 4 years old for L.K.G. Admission requires an interaction session with the child and their parents.
24. At the time of admission, a valid Birth Certificate issued by the Municipality or Panchayath, Aadhar Cards of both parents and the student (2 copies each), Income Certificate, Caste Certificate, and 2 passport-size photos are required to be submitted.
25. The admission process for L.K.G. starts in the first week of January each year. For more details about admission, please contact the school office at the following phone numbers: 9448239408 or 9480299190.
26. Guardians are requested to fill out the admission form with utmost accuracy. No changes will be permitted thereafter for any reason.

Examination & Promotion

27. Students have two major exams each year, Term 1 and Term 2, along with four periodic assessments and regular unit tests. The passing mark is 40%, and students must bring their hall ticket for every exam.
28. Promotions are based on one year's overall performance, not just the marks from the final exams. Attendance for both major exams is mandatory. At the end of the year, the average of both major exams is considered. A total aggregate of 40% in each subject is required for

promotion. Additionally, classwork and homework are also assessed and contribute to the evaluation.

29. Each student is required to be present for 90% of school days as a pre-condition for promotion.
30. Grades, and not ranks, are given to the children after each examination. No grade will be given if a child has failed or is absent in any subject. Final examination answer scripts will not be shown.
31. There shall be neither a re-test nor a re-exam.
32. The result declared at the end of the year is final and cannot be reconsidered. In all questions of promotion or failure, the Principal's decision is final.
33. If a pupil does not pass in all the subjects any concession he/she enjoys will be cancelled.
34. Anyone who resorts to unfair means in the examinations will be dismissed instantly. **Withdrawal / Expulsion**
35. Before withdrawing a student from the school a month's notice is to be given or a month's fee instead of notice.
36. No school leaving certificate will be issued unless requested in writing by the parent and all the dues are cleared.
37. Any pupil failing in two years in succession in the same class or failing twice in three consecutive years will be struck off the rolls and cannot continue in the school.
38. Without prior notice to the parents, the Principal reserves to himself the right to dismiss a student, who fails to make satisfactory progress in his/her studies or whose conduct in any way detrimental to the discipline of the institution, such as immorality, insubordination or contempt of authority.
39. Not anything in the prospectus; the Principal may at his absolute discretion ask any parent at any time to take his/her ward out of the school.

Conveyance

40. Conveyance facility may be arranged by the school for children who can be brought to a particular stop, but a seat on the bus is not guaranteed. Arrangements must be made by the guardian to bring the children to the bus stop and take them back home.
41. Conveyance facilities cannot be extended.
42. Even for the partial use of the conveyance, fees for 11 months will be charged.
43. Conveyance facilities may be withdrawn for disciplinary reasons.

Recommendations to Parents

1. Parents and guardians are requested to cooperate with the school authorities in all matters concerning the formation and education of their child. Parents are to look into the diary every evening and see to it that the lesson and homework assigned to the next day are done. Remarks made by the Principal, Vice-Principal, or the Teachers should be seen and countersigned.
2. Criticisms of the child's teacher at his school in the presence of the child should be avoided.
3. If the parents have any grievance against any of the teachers, they are advised to meet the Principal and settle the matter amicably.

Important Notes to Parents

1. Students will not be allowed to leave the school during class hours.
2. Latecomers are not allowed to attend the class.
3. Slow learners and those who habitually fail to do their homework or learn lessons will be detained in the school even without prior information, to complete their unfinished lessons. It would be the parent's responsibility to pick them up from the school.
4. If the leave of absence exceeds **One Day** a written application is to be sent to the Principal and the same may be produced along with the reason for absence recorded in the Regularity Record of the Diary.
5. Fee should be paid as per directions in the fee book.
